- Sensitize your child about the rich culture and heritage by watching different informative channels like "The National Geographic", "Animal Planet" etc.

- Papa, can we go to watch a movie today?

- Papa, can we go to the stationary? I need to buy things for my holiday homework?
- Didi, shall we ask mom and dad to take us for a picnic?
- Didi, can I work on your laptop?
- Grandpa/ Grandma, Do you need anything? Shall I bring you a glass of water?
- Grandpa/ Grandma, can you please narrate a story for me?


